



Convergence College Network One-Minute Student Video Directions

CCN schools earn two points for submitting a student testimonial video to showcase student success and spotlight the great work programs like yours are doing. It can be a graduate of your program who's already got a great job or one of your top students whose life has been changed and faces a very bright future.

These videos were a request of the National CTC's National Visiting Committee (the expert review panel that meets each spring to evaluate the CTC grant).

* We want to make this process as simple as possible. Using a smartphone, film your student answering the questions below and then send the entire un-edited video to the National CTC. If it's too large a file to email, the CTC will provide you with a Dropbox URL. Or – if you already have a Dropbox – you can upload the file there and send the CTC a link.

* Selfie videos are 100% okay.

* Diversity (in the classroom and in the workforce) remains an ongoing challenge in the IT world, so please keep that in mind when selecting students.

* It's also okay to send us several videos of several different students.

* When making the recording, keep the image horizontal (landscape) and try to find a quiet place without background noise. Frame the subject from the shoulders up.

* Tell your subject not to worry about “ums” or “uh” or any kind of gap or pause in the testimonial. That will all be edited out.
